

GRADES 3 & 4: SUPPLY LIST for 2010 - 2011

The following are the supplies your child will need to begin the school year.

Classroom doors open at 8:45 a.m.; students are asked to arrive and prepare before 9 a.m.

Our day begins at 9 a.m. with prayer and ends with prayer at 3:25 p.m. Pick up begins at 3:30 p.m.

- 1 package (8-12 count) color markers
- 1 package crayons (24 count or larger)
- 1 yellow hi-liter marker
- color pencils (8-12 count)
- pencils – a good supply (not mechanical)
- 1 red ink pen (not erasable)
- 2 glue sticks **and** 1 liquid glue
- scissors
- rulers – not flexible, please; with *centimeter and inch* measurements (☺ Buy two please, and keep one at home.)
- erasers – 1 chunk eraser and 2 packages of pencil top erasers
- 1 large plastic protractor (3rd grade only)
- 4 packages college-ruled notebook paper (Please look for sale prices.)
- 2 70-sheet wide-ruled spiral notebooks (Please look for sale prices.)
- a ½” 3-ring poly binder
- a 1” 3-ring poly binder (new students only)
- multiplication and division flash cards (for home use as needed)
- 1 zippered pencil bag (with holes for a 3-ring binder)
- 1 medium-sized pencil box for daily use (must fit into student’s desk)
- 1 *shoebox size* plastic box for art supplies
- 1 book bag or backpack **and** a gym bag (see next item)
- a gym bag (Hint: try a store brand “Green” shopping bag for a gym bag.)
- a physical education uniform (see order form)
- outdoor shoes for the playground
- 2 boxes Kleenex, 2 rolls paper towel, 2 pkgs. cleaning wipes, 1 pkg. 5 oz. paper cups, 2 pkgs. plastic spoons
- a water bottle
- A reusable lunch bag with a freezer pack is recommended
- \$3.00 for additional supplies (due by September 10, please)
- Other classroom supplies (e.g., paper plates, napkins) will be requested at conference time.

**A note will be written on the student’s homework sheet when personal supplies need to be replenished.
