

2010-2011 Middle School Girl's Supply List

For student's desk

- 1 hard-sided pencil case
- 1 clear shoe box
- *a supply of red pens (~10)
- *a supply of black pens (20-40), which may be ballpoint or erasable, no retractable or gel pens please
- *a supply of pencils (~50) or mechanical pencils and lead (~ 2 pkgs of lead per month of school) or a combination of the above
- a ruler
- a pair of scissors
- *a supply of "chunky" (6) and pencil-top erasers (30)
- a simple rosary
- 3 heavy duty, hard-cover 1" binders with inside pocket/sleeves (no cloth-covered binders)
- 10 binder divider tabs
- 10-20 clear page protectors
- 3 folders (at least 2 need inside brackets)
- *a supply of highlighters (4-6) – they may be any color
- *a supply of white out (2-4)– if it is the tape kind, make sure the brand works before you buy a lot, many of them broke last year on the girls. I found Staples brand to hold up quite well.
- 1 package (there are usually about four in a package) of rings used for index cards or papers
- spiral bound notebooks – **college ruled, perforated sheets with three holes punched**
 - 3 green
 - 1 blue
 - 4 black
 - 2 yellow (or two identical of another color)
 - 2 red (or two identical of another color)
- 1 sharpie (very fine) and one sharpie (normal width)
- 1 water bottle to reuse and keep at school, or \$2 to Ms. Wall, and your child will receive a new "disposable" water bottle each month. It is very important that your child always has a water bottle at school for P.E. and other purposes.
- An extra pair of socks (for those days when rain soaks the first pair)

For the classroom supply

- 5 packages of loose leaf paper (college ruled)
- 3 packages of index cards (2 lined and 1 blank)
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 2 containers of sanitizing wipes
- 1 ream of computer paper
- 1 package of spoons **and** either 1 package of forks or 1 combo package (spoons/forks/knives)

* Items listed with "a supply of" have *suggested* yearly quantities. Not all of the supplies for the school year need to be sent in at the beginning of the year.

Students **DO NOT NEED** – calculators, compasses, liquid glue, pens with ink other than black or red, or protractors. These are kept as classroom supplies. The classroom is also furnished with crayons, colored pencils and markers. Students may still opt to bring their own.

Optional (absolutely optional) supplies –

- coloring/drawing supplies and/or calligraphy pens

Students also need appropriate school and P.E. uniform pieces every day of the school year. Please particularly double-check that all socks are consistent with the dress code.

Classroom wish list –

- 2 boxes of standard-size bandaids with antibiotic ointment on them
- 1 box of assorted size bandaids
- cough drops
- tall and medium trash bags
- liquid soap refills
- Art supplies
 - colored computer paper for art, classroom decoration and projects
 - art clay that does not need firing
 - drawing or painting paper
 - paints, paint brushes, pastels, charcoal or other similar art supplies
 - crocheting hooks, sizes H 1st preference, then G, then I; yarn
 - old, broken, or unwanted crayons
 - wax paper and aluminum foil
 - white and colored tissue paper
 - ribbon (all colors, thick and thin)
- a working, but unwanted cassette and/or CD player
- a single hole punch
- plastic shoeboxes or similar sized containers to hold supplies in closet
- a large world map
- clipboards (7-8)
- a “stand-up” desk – raisers to bring a desk to working height while standing
- **saint books, particularly chapter books**
- **Bibles (Catholic only please) and Catechisms**
- **needles, white, black, gray or maroon thread (especially gray and maroon), clothing (straight) pins, safety pins and replacement buttons (are you throwing away a shirt, skirt or sweater that is “shot”?)**

Items in **bold** are particularly desired
